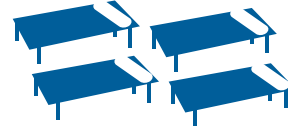
Rescued 1,300,367lbs of food and distributed to 23 local schools and agencies

Sheltered men & women 43,968 nights

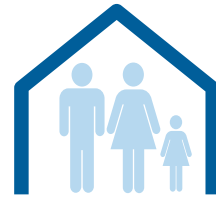


Supported 5,597 to vulnerable youth

Lifted Up Thousands by providing case management, education, work opportunities, medical supports, rehabilitation and housing

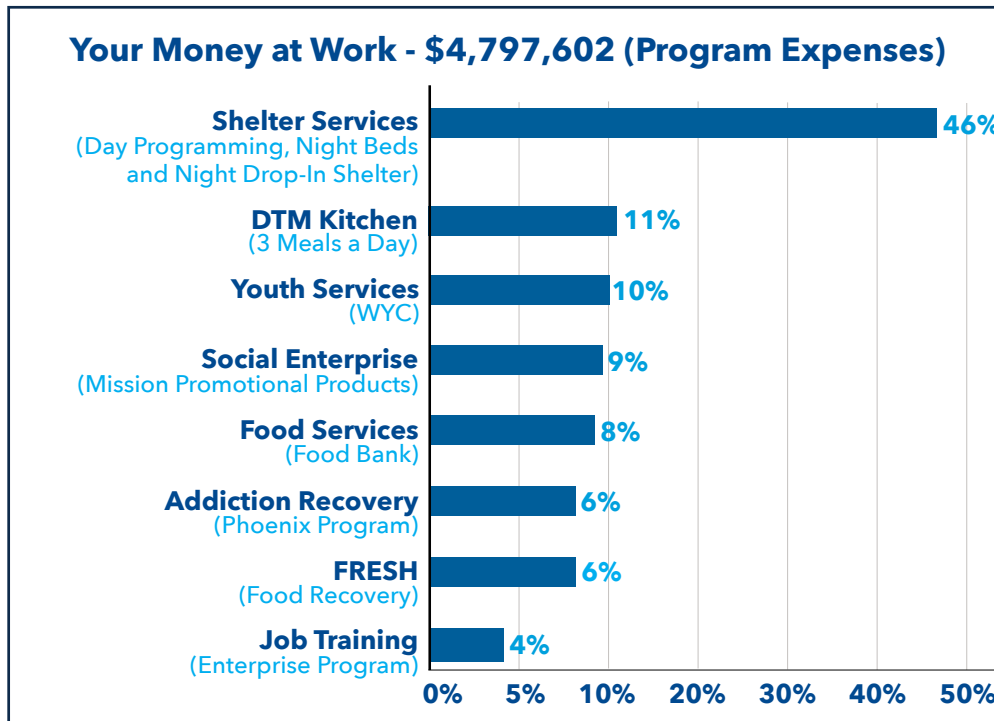
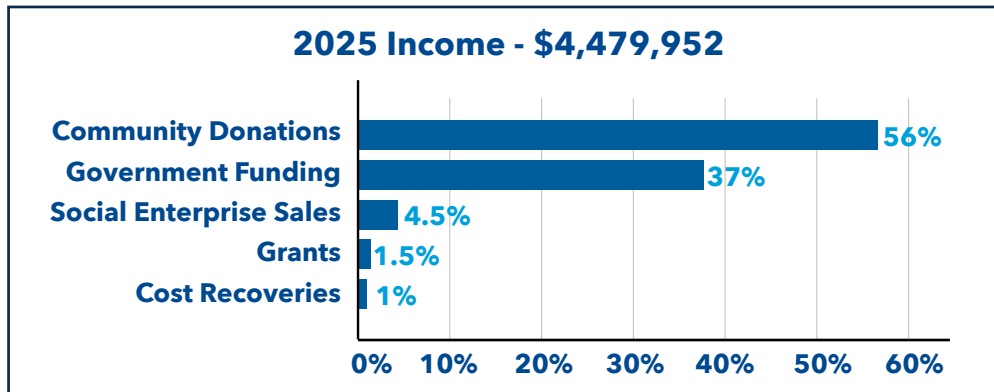
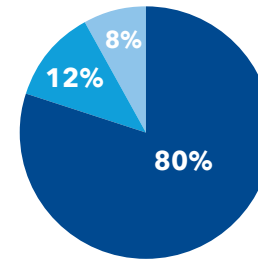

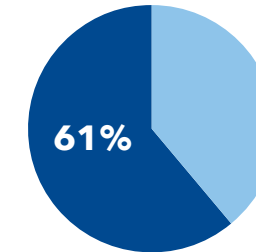


- The Mission gratefully accepted \$2,056,046 of In-Kind Donations in 2025
